This version of facility specific terms and conditions was converted from a database format to an HTML file during an upgrade of the Ohio EPA, Division of Air Pollution Control's permitting software. Every attempt has been made to convert the terms and conditions to look and substantively conform to the permit issued or being drafted in STARS. However, the format of the terms may vary slightly from the original. In addition, although it is not expected, there is a slight possibility that a term and condition may have been inadvertently "left out" of this reproduction during the conversion process. Therefore, if this version is to be used as a starting point in drafting a new version of a permit, it is imperative that the entire set of terms and conditions be reviewed to ensure they substantively mimic the issued permit. 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**Part II - Special Terms and Conditions**

This permit document constitutes a permit-to-install issued in accordance with ORC 3704.03(F) and a permit-to-operate issued in accordance with ORC 3704.03(G).

**B. Operational Restrictions**

1. The pressure drop across the cartridge filters shall be maintained within the range of 0.5 to 4.0 inches of water while this emissions unit is in operation.

**C. Monitoring and/or Record Keeping Requirements**

1. The permittee shall properly install, operate, and maintain equipment to monitor the pressure drop across the cartridge filters while the emissions unit is in operation. The monitoring equipment shall be installed, calibrated, operated, and maintained in accordance with the manufacturer's recommendations with any modifications deemed necessary by the permittee. The permittee shall record the pressure drop across the cartridge filters on a daily basis.

**D. Reporting Requirements**

1. The permittee shall submit quarterly pressure drop deviation (excursion) reports that identify all periods of time during which the pressure drop across the cartridge filters did not comply with the allowable range specified above.

**E. Testing Requirements**

1. Compliance with the emission limitation(s) of these terms and conditions shall be determined in accordance with the following method(s):  
Emission Limitation-  
0.02 lb/hr PE  
  
Applicable Compliance Method-  
Compliance shall be determined by multiplying the maximum capacity of this process (96 lbs/hr) by the emission factor of 1.7 E 1 lbs/ton gray iron produced which corresponds to SCC 3-04-003-40 from the from the Fire Version 5.0 SCC and Emission Factor Listing for Criteria Air Pollutants, 1995 and the control efficiency of the cartridge filters (1 - 0.98).  
Emission Limitation-  
0.09 TPY PE  
Applicable Compliance Method-  
Compliance shall be determined by multiplying the maximum hourly emission rate of 0.02 lb/hr by the annual

maximum hours of operation, 8760 hrs/yr and converting to tons.

Emission Limitation-  
5% opacity, as a six minute average

Applicable Compliance Method-

Compliance shall be determined by visible emission evaluations in accordance with OAC rule 3745-17-03(B)(1) using methods and procedures specified in USEPA Reference Method 9.
