This letter is to notify you that the application(s) you submitted for a permit(s) to operate for the above referenced air contaminant emission unit(s) has been reviewed by the Ohio EPA.

The air emission potential from the emission unit(s) is (are) of an amount and type that is considered minimal by the Ohio EPA in accordance with OAC rule 3745-35-05. Consequently, the Ohio EPA staff has recommended to the Director that the emission unit(s) is (are) to be placed on registration status. This means that the emission unit(s) is (are) placed in our computer file permanent record. Further, you will not be required to renew a permit for this (these) emission unit(s) every three years.

This action does not affect your legal obligation to comply with all applicable State and federal regulations including emission regulations. Also, this action in no way precludes the Director's option of requiring, in the future, an updated application to reevaluate the need to issue a permit to operate for this emission unit(s).

It must be filed with the Environmental Review Appeals Commission within thirty (30) days after notice of the Director's action. A copy of the appeal must be served on the Director of the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency within three (3) days of filing with the Commission.
