RESCHEDULED PUBLIC HEARING

Public notice is hereby given that the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Division of Air Pollution Control issued on December 13, 2002 a preliminary staff determination for Federally Enforceable State Permit to Operate (FESOP) application No. 0125040904 to Georgia-Pacific Resins. This draft FESOP applies to the Plant No 1 and Plant No 2 metal oxide processes for urea-formaldehyde production- vented to a thermal oxidizer and to the resin kettles K-1 and K-3- vented to a thermal oxidizer and having emergency containment systems. All units are located at the Georgia-Pacific Resins facility at 1975 Watkins Road, Columbus, Ohio.

A public information session and public hearing on the draft air permit *that was originally scheduled for Wednesday, January 13 is here by rescheduled for Monday, January 27, 2003, at Beery Middle School, 2740 Lockbourne Road, Columbus, Ohio (Franklin County).* The public information session will begin at 6:30 p.m. The public hearing will commence at 7:15 p.m. to accept comments on the draft permit. A presiding officer will be present and may limit oral testimony to ensure that all parties are heard.

All interested persons are entitled to attend or be represented and give written or oral comments on the draft permit at the hearing. Written comments must be received by the Ohio EPA, Central District Office, Division of Air Pollution Control by the close of the business day of February 3, 2003. Comments received after this date will not be considered to be a part of the official record.
