This letter is in response to your submittal of the above-referenced application. The Ohio EPA, Northeast District Office has completed a preliminary completeness review of the documents and has concluded the application is complete. This completeness determination does not imply the application is approvable, only that we have determined we have enough information to continue a review of the application.

It should be noted that some applicable requirements were left off the permit application. See enclosed checklist. The issuance of the pending PTI will satisfy the VOC requirements for the new sources.

The next step in the processing of the application is for this office to complete a technical review. The technical reviews are completed on a "first come, first serve" basis. When the technical review is completed a permit reviewer may contact you for additional information or for clarification on the application. Once the technical review is complete, a recommendation will be forwarded to the Ohio EPA Division of Air Pollution Control (DAPC) for review. If the DAPC concludes the recommendation is appropriate, then the application will be approved or the application will be denied.
