We'd like to know if the GACT (JJJJJJ) was stayed or just the MACT (DDDDD) and CISWI.</p> <p><i>Answer: 6J was not stayed, just the other two major source MACT rules. 3	<p>Ken J. NEDO Since July 1, 2011, major GHG emitters (100,000 tpy potential) are supposed to somehow have their major GHG emitter status acknowledged in initial and renewal Title V Permits. At least that's my take on the matter. Correct?</p> <p>How are we gonna do so? I have been working on the renewal for West Lorain Plant and it was issued a PPP action in March 2011. (Its processing stalled after First Energy Corp (owner of Ohio Edison which operates it) commented adversely on some language in the Part A Std Terms and Conditions. In response Ohio EPA proposed some changes to them and gave an extended public comment period on the Part A std terms & conditions proposed revisions, which then closed on Sept 16th.)</p> <p>The company has not informed me that they are a major for GHG, but by making a rough calc I can guess West Lorain Plt is one. Do all the Title V Permit holders with renewals pending have to formally inform us of their major GHG status in Stars2?</p> <p>I can 'check' the GHG major block on the permit page in Stars, will that cause their status to be listed as a GHG major emitter in the permit? Are we going to add some language about GHG and if so where in the permit will it be placed?</p>	Hopkins
