**COVENANT NOT TO SUE/FINAL FINDINGS AND ORDERS**  
**General Electric Credit Equities, Inc.(Springfield Place)**

Notice is hereby given that on February 22, 2005, the Director of the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency ("Ohio EPA"), pursuant to Ohio Revised Code ("ORC") Chapter 3746 and Ohio Administrative Code ("OAC") Chapter 3745-300, issued a Covenant Not To Sue/Final Findings and Orders to General Electric Credit Equities, Inc. for the property identified as the Springfield Place property (the "Property").

General Electric Credit Equities, Inc. conducted a voluntary action of the approximately 3.5 acre-Property located at 1030 to 1068 Upper Valley Pike, Springfield, Clark County, Ohio. A no further action letter was submitted on November 22, 2004 to the Voluntary Action Program of the Ohio EPA Division of Emergency and Remedial Response on behalf of General Electric Credit Equities, Inc. by James E. Zentmeyer, a Certified Professional (CP252), as defined in ORC 3746.01(E) and OAC 3745-300-01(A)(8).

The issuance of the Covenant Not to Sue/Final Findings and Orders is a final action of the Director. The action may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission ("Commission"). The appeal must be in writing and set forth the action complained of and the grounds upon which the appeal is based. The appeal must be filed with the Commission within thirty (30) days after notice or issuance of the action. (See ORC 3745.04 and 3745.07). A copy of the appeal must be served on the Director within three (3) days after the appeal is filed with the Commission. The appeal may be filed with the Commission at 309 South Fourth St., Room 222, Columbus, Ohio 43215.

**OHIO EPA ISSUES FINAL MODIFIED HAZARDOUS WASTE PERMIT**

On February 25, 2005, Ohio EPA issued a final Class 2 modified Hazardous Waste Facility Installation and Operation Permit (Permit) to BP Amoco Chemical Company (BP Chemical) for its facility at 1900 Fort Amanda Road, Lima, Ohio 45802. The EPA Identification Number for this facility is OHD042157644.

**Why is BP Chemical modifying its Permit?**

BP Chemical is permitted to operate hazardous waste container and tank storage units, tank treatment, an incinerator and other related hazardous waste management units at its facility. BP Chemical wants to replace the Ground-Water Monitoring Plan for the Land Disposal Cells Revision 5 with Revision 6. The entire ground-water monitoring plan has been revised to reflect the change in status of wells 91-T2, 91-T6, 91-T10, and 91-T13 from monitoring wells to piezometers. Additionally, the ground water monitoring plan has been revised to reflect the facility's change in ownership from BP Chemicals Inc. to BP Amoco Chemical Company. This final modified permit will allow BP Chemicals to make the requested changes. To issue this final modified Permit, Ohio EPA determined that the modification application is complete and meets appropriate standards.

**Can I appeal this final modified Permit?**

Yes, if you are an officer of an agency of the state or of a political subdivision, acting in a representative capacity, or any person who would be aggrieved or adversely affected by this modified Permit, you have the right to appeal this Permit decision to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission (ERAC).

**If I decide to appeal this final modified Permit, how and when must I make the appeal?**

If you file an appeal, you must put it in writing no later than **March 27, 2005**. Your appeal must explain why you are appealing the action and the grounds you are using for your appeal. You must file your appeal, according to ORC § 3745.04, with ERAC at the following address: ***Environmental Review Appeals Commission***, 309 South Fourth Street, Room 222, Columbus, Ohio 43215. NOTICE OF RECEIPT OF 401 APPLICATION**

Public notice is hereby given that the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) Division of Surface Water (DSW) has received an application for, and has begun to consider whether to issue or deny, a Clean Water Act Section 401 certification for a project to stabilize eroding streambank. The application was submitted by Raymond Wolfe, 6840 Havensport Rd, Carroll, Ohio 43112. As required by the Antidegradation Rule, three alternatives have been submitted for the project. The applicant's proposed preferred alternative, if approved, would stabilize 450 linear feet of stream. The applicant's proposed minimal degradation alternative, if approved, would stabilize 250 linear feet. The applicant's proposed non-degradation alternative, if approved, would have no direct impacts on streams or wetlands. The project is located east of Havensport Road and south of Bish Road, Carroll, Fairfield County, Ohio. The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Number for this project is NW13-200401404. The Ohio EPA ID Number for this project is 052229.

The discharges from the activity, if approved, would result in degradation to, or lowering of, the water quality of Poplar Creek watershed. The review of the application will be conducted, and a decision whether to grant or deny the application will be made, in accordance with Chapters 3745-1 and 3745-32 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC). In accordance with OAC 3745-1-05, an antidegradation review of the application will be conducted before deciding whether to allow a lowering of the water quality. Other alternatives resulting in lesser or no degradation, or lowering of water quality, will be considered by Ohio EPA during the review process.

No exclusions or waivers, as outlined by Paragraph 3745-1-05 (D) of the Antidegradation Rule (effective as of May 1, 1998), apply or may be granted by the Director of Ohio EPA.

Starting March 2, 2005, copies of the application for the certification and technical support information may be inspected at Ohio EPA/DSW, Lazarus Government Center, 122 South Front Street, Columbus, Ohio, by first calling (614) 644-2001. Applications can be made available at Ohio EPA District Offices by calling the same number.
