RENEWAL OF LABORATORY CERTIFICATION UNDER OHIO'S VOLUNTARY
ACTION PROGRAM**

Notice is hereby given that on February 12, 2007, the Director of the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency ("Ohio EPA"), pursuant to Ohio Revised Code ("ORC") 3746.04(B)(6) and Ohio Administrative Code ("OAC") 3745-300-04, issued a renewal of laboratory certification to Zande Environmental Services ("Zande") of 1233 Dublin Road, Columbus, Ohio. The certification number assigned to Zande remains CL0054.

The issuance of the renewal certification is a final action of the Director and will be public noticed in accordance with OAC 3745-47-07. The action may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission ("Commission"). The appeal must be in writing and set forth the action complained of and the grounds upon which the appeal is based. The appeal must be filed with the Commission within thirty (30) days after notice or issuance of the action. See ORC 3745.04 and 3745.07. A copy of the appeal must be served on the Director within three (3) days after the appeal is filed with the Commission. The appeal may be filed with the Commission at 309 South Fourth Street, Room 222, Columbus, OH 43215.

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Notice is hereby given that on February 12, 2007, the Director of the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency ("Ohio EPA"), pursuant to Ohio Revised Code ("ORC") 3746.04(B)(6) and Ohio Administrative Code ("OAC") 3745-300-04, issued a renewal of laboratory certification to Trimatrix Laboratories, Inc. ("Trimatrix") of 5560 Corporate Exchange Court, Grand Rapids, Michigan. The Director has also approved of Trimatrix's requests to remove Cyanide by method 335.4 from its certification. The certification number assigned to Trimatrix remains CL0081.

The issuance of the renewal certification is a final action of the Director and will be public noticed in accordance with OAC 3745-47-07. The action may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission ("Commission"). The appeal must be in writing and set forth the action complained of and the grounds upon which the appeal is based. The appeal must be filed with the Commission within thirty (30) days after notice or issuance of the action. See ORC 3745.04 and 3745.07. A copy of the appeal must be served on the Director within three (3) days after the appeal is filed with the Commission. OHIO EPA ISSUES FINAL FINDINGS AND ORDERS TO
NORMAN NOBLE, INC.**

On February 9, 2007, Ohio EPA issued final Findings and Orders to Norman Noble, Inc. for its facility located at 1650 Collamer Road, Cleveland, Ohio 44110. This facility is a large quantity generator of hazardous waste. The EPA I.D. number for this facility is OHR000018374.

Norman Noble, Inc., must achieve compliance with Chapter 3734 of the Ohio Revised Code and all corresponding regulations according to the detailed compliance schedule which outlines civil penalties and payments. This final action was not preceded by a proposed action and is appealable to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission.

OHIO EPA ISSUES DRAFT HAZARDOUS WASTE FACILITY INSTALLATION AND OPERATION PERMIT FOR USA LAMP & BALLAST RECYCLING, INC.

On February 16, 2007, Ohio EPA issued a draft Hazardous Waste Facility Installation and Operation Permit (Permit) for USA Lamp and Ballast Recycling, Inc. (USA Lamp) for its facility located at 7806 Anthony Wayne Avenue, Cincinnati, Ohio 45216. The EPA Identification Number for this facility is OHR000109819.

Why does USA Lamp & Ballast Recycling, Inc. need a Permit?

On October 21 2005, USA Lamp qualified for permit by rule status for its facility in Cincinnati, Ohio. USA Lamp acts as a destination facility for hazardous waste lamps prior to the recycling process at the facility. To store the hazardous wastes, USA Lamp needs a Permit. The draft Permit contains the conditions under which the facility must operate if the Permit receives final approval. To issue this draft Permit, Ohio EPA determined that the Part B permit application is complete and complies with appropriate standards and that the applicant has exhibited sufficient reliability, expertise and competency to operate a hazardous waste facility. When issued, the final Permit will allow USA Lamp to store hazardous waste in the designated areas at the facility. When and where will Ohio EPA hold a Public Meeting?

You may request Ohio EPA to hold a public meeting for this draft permit. What will Ohio EPA do with the comments?

Public notice is hereby given that Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) Division of Surface Water (DSW) has issued a draft plan approval for the Long Term Control Plan and Wastewater Treatment Plant and Collection System Comprehensive Plan for the City of Napoleon. The plan is to eliminate all sanitary sewer overflows, to close the combined sewer overflows (CSOs) that are located on Oberhaus Creek, and to limit CSO events that discharge to the Maumee River to no more than four per year. All sewage from separately sewered areas will receive full primary and secondary treatment at the wastewater plant. All flows from combined sewer areas that reach the wastewater plant will receive a minimum of primary-equivalent treatment and disinfection. The estimated cost of the plan, which will be implemented over a 20 year period, is \$34,990,000. The City's NPDES permit, Ohio EPA permit number 2PD00000*OD, is being modified to include a compliance schedule for implementation of the approved plan.

In accordance with OAC 3745-1-05, Ohio EPA will provide an opportunity for public comment concerning this project. Comments received shall be considered by the Director before the plan is issued as final. Any person may submit written comments on the draft plan and administrative record and may request a public hearing. A request for public hearing shall be in writing and shall state the nature of the issues to be raised. In

appropriate cases, including cases where there is significant public interest, the director may hold a public hearing on a draft plan or plans prior to final issuance of the plan or plans. Written comments and/or public hearing requests must be received by the Ohio EPA, Division of Surface Water no later than 30 days from the February 16, 2007 of this public notice. Comments and/or public hearing requests should be delivered or mailed to both of the following locations: 1) Ohio Environmental Protection Agency, Division of Surface Water, Permits Processing Unit, 50 West Town Street, Suite 700, P.O. Box 1049, Columbus, Ohio 43216-1049 and 2) Ohio Environmental Protection Agency, Northwest District Office, 347 North Dunbridge Road, Bowling Green, OH 43402. Comments received after this February 16, 2007 may not be considered by the Director before issuing the final plan.
