**OHIO EPA APPROVES AMENDED CLOSURE PLAN FOR
CLEVELAND MUNICIPAL CENTER**

On November 7, 2007, Ohio EPA approved an amended post-closure plan for the Cleveland Municipal Center for its former underground storage tanks located at 5800 & 6000 Carnegie Avenue, Cleveland, Ohio. The EPA I.D. numbers for this facility are OHR000005538 and OHR000005546.

Pursuant to Ohio Revised Code rule 3745-66-11, 12, and 18, the facility's amended post-closure plan submitted on April 30, 2007 was approved as outlined in the Director's November 7, 2007 correspondence. This final action was not preceded by a proposed action and is appealable to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission.

PROPOSED CONSENT ORDER**

The Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) has entered into a Consent Order with Robert Mauer (Defendant) to resolve allegations of violations of Ohio Revised Code (R.C.) Chapter 6111 associated with numerous violations of water pollution control laws of the State of Ohio at the River Bend Mobile Home Park near McClure, Ohio. The complaint was filed by the State of Ohio in Wood County Court of Common Pleas case number 06 CV 232. Under the proposed Consent Order, Defendant is permanently enjoined and immediately ordered to comply with requirements of R.C. Chapter 6111 and the rules adopted thereunder. Specifically, Defendant is required to immediately comply with the terms and conditions of the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System Permit (#2PY00026) and any renewals or modifications for the Waste Water Treatment Plant at River Bend. Also, the proposed Consent Order stipulates that the Defendant shall pay the State of Ohio a civil penalty of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00) and in lieu of additional civil penalties fund a supplemental environmental project for the Bowling Green Parks and Recreation Foundation in the amount of twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000).

Written comments should be submitted to the Ohio EPA, Northwest District Office, at the above address. Written comments should be submitted on or before December 21, 2007.

The final approval and entry of the proposed Consent Order will not occur until after the thirty-day public comment period has expired. The thirty-day period commences on November 21, 2007. Both the State of Ohio and Robert Mauer reserve the right to withdraw or alter the proposed Consent Order based on comments received during the public comment period.
