### OHIO EPA ISSUES FINAL MODIFIED HAZARDOUS WASTE PERMIT

On September 10, 2008, Ohio EPA issued a final modified hazardous waste facility installation and operation permit (Hazardous Waste Permit) to The Lubrizol Corporation (Lubrizol), for its facility at 155 Freedom Road, Painesville, Ohio 44077. The EPA Identification Number for this facility is OHD004172623.

#### **Why does Lubrizol need this Permit modification?**

The Lubrizol Corporation in Painesville is engaged in the manufacture of lubricant additives, fuel additives, and other speciality chemicals related to the transportation industry. From these activities, hazardous waste is generated. Lubrizol is authorized to store and treat hazardous waste in tanks, and treat hazardous waste by incineration. The Director of Ohio EPA initiated this modification to authorize Lubrizol to perform specific corrective action measures as part of its site-wide corrective action. Ohio EPA has reviewed the facility's investigation information collected to date and recommends that an Environmental Covenant be placed on the property. To issue this final modified permit, Ohio EPA determined that the completed corrective measures meet appropriate standards.

#### **Can I appeal this modified permit?**

Yes, if you are an officer of an agency of the state or of a political subdivision, acting in a representative capacity, or any person who would be aggrieved or adversely affected by this Permit, you have the right to appeal this permit decision to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission (ERAC).

#### **If I decide to appeal this final modified Permit, how and when must I make the appeal?**

If you file an appeal, you must put it in writing no later than October 14, 2008. Your appeal must explain why you are appealing the action and the grounds you are using for your appeal. The appeal must be accompanied by a filing fee of \$70.00 which the Commission, in its discretion, may reduce if by affidavit you demonstrate that payment of the full amount of the fee would cause extreme hardship. NOTICE OF RECEIPT OF 401 APPLICATION**

Public notice is hereby given that the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) Division of Surface Water (DSW) has received an application for, and has begun to consider whether to issue or deny, a Clean Water Act Section 401 certification for the proposed transportation project consisting of 0.89 miles of a proposed roadway in Washington Township, Muskingum Co. Ohio. The proposed roadway currently known as Jim Granger Drive, will be a two lane road providing access through the EastPoint Industrial Park to the JRS ( Jobs Ready Site ) and Avon, among others. Approximately 11.53 acres of land area will be required for the project. The application was submitted by The Muskingum County Port Authority/Muskingum County Engineers Office, 155 Rehl Road, Zanesville, Ohio 43701, The Huntington District of the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Number for this project is 2007-947. The Ohio EPA ID Number for this project is 083406.

As required by the Antidegradation Rule, three alternatives have been submitted for the project. The applicant's proposed preferred alternative, if approved, would involve impacts of a total of 260 feet of stream channel, and the placement of fill in 0.11 acres of wetlands. The applicant's proposed minimal degradation alternative, if approved, would involve impacts to wetlands area of 0.09 acres. The length of impact on Little Salt Creek decreases from 260 linear feet to 185 linear feet. The applicant's proposed non-degradation alternative, if approved, would have no direct impacts on streams or wetlands but would not meet the purpose and need for the project.

The discharges from the activity, if approved, would result in degradation to, or lowering of the water quality to streams and wetlands in the the Muskingum River drainage basin (HUC 05040004). The review of the application will be conducted, and a decision whether to grant or deny the application will be made, in accordance with Chapters 3745-1 and 3745-32 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC). In accordance with OAC 3745-1-05, an antidegradation review of the application will be conducted before deciding whether to allow a lowering of the water quality. Other alternatives resulting in lesser or no degradation, or lowering of water quality, will be considered by Ohio EPA during the review process.

No exclusions or waivers, as outlined by Paragraph 3745-1-05 (D) of the Antidegradation Rule (effective as of May 1, 1998), apply or may be granted by the Director of Ohio EPA.
