NOTICE OF RECEIPT OF 401 APPLICATION**

Public notice is hereby given that the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) Division of Surface Water (DSW) has received an application for, and has begun to consider whether to issue or deny, a Clean Water Act Section 401 certification for a New Bulkhead addition at Miller Boat Line Downtown Dock, Put-in-Bay, OH. The application was submitted by The Market Corporation, 565 Bayview Avenue, Put-in-Bay, Ohio 43456. The Buffalo District of the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Public Notice Number is 2009-01446. The Ohio EPA ID Number for this project is 103604.

As required by the Antidegradation Rule, rule 3745-1-05 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC), three alternatives have been submitted for the project. The applicant's proposed preferred alternative, if approved, would construct a new 30' X 20' triangular steel sheet pile addition to the Miller Boat Line Downtown Dock, in Put-in-Bay, OH with a 5' wide ODOT "C" fish habitat stone along the toe of the sheet piling for mitigation. Approx. 360 SF of new lake bottom will be filled below OHW, and 134 CY of new fill will be placed below OHW. The applicant's proposed minimal degradation alternative, if approved, would construct a new 23' X 19' triangular steel sheet pile addition to the Miller Boat Line Downtown Dock in Put-in-Bay, OH with a 5' wide ODOT "C" fish habitat stone along the toe of the sheet piling for mitigation. Approx. 220 SF of new lake bottom will be filled below OHW and 84 CY of new fill will be placed below OHW. The applicant's proposed non-degradation alternative, if approved, would have no direct impacts on streams or wetlands or lake habitat.

Discharges from the activity, if approved, would result in degradation to, or lowering of, the water quality of Lake Erie. Ohio EPA will review the application, and decide whether to grant or deny the application, in accordance with OAC Chapters 3745-1 and 3745-32. In accordance with OAC 3745-1-05, an antidegradation review of the application will be conducted before deciding whether to allow a lowering of the water quality. All three proposed alternatives will be considered during the review process. No exclusions or waivers, as outlined by OAC rule 3745-1-05, apply or may be granted.
