FWPCA Section 303(d) TMDL PRIORITY LIST FOR 2012**

Public notice is hereby given that the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) Division of Surface Water (DSW) is providing for public review and comment the Total Maximum Daily Load (TMDL) priority list for 2012 as required by Section 303(d) of the Federal Water Pollution Control Act, 33 U.S.C. Section 1313(d). The list indicates the waters of Ohio that are currently impaired and may require TMDL development in order to meet water quality standards. The waters are ranked according to level of impairment to help indicate which have the greatest need for TMDL development. The list is contained within the *2012 Integrated Water Quality Monitoring and Assessment Report*, which in accordance with federal guidance, satisfies the Clean Water Act requirements for both Section 305(b) water quality reports and Section 303(d) lists. The report describes the procedure that Ohio EPA used to develop the list and indicates which areas have been selected for TMDL development during FFY 2012 through 2014. Ohio EPA will hold a public information session on January 11, 2012, at 3:30 p.m. The meeting will be held at the Ohio EPA, Conference Room A, 50 West Town Street, Suite 700, Columbus, OH 43215.
