AND PUBLIC HEARING**

Public notice is hereby given that the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) Division of Surface Water (DSW) has received an application and has developed DRAFT Clean Water Act section 401 water quality certifications for the following Nationwide Permits as proposed in the Wednesday, February 16, 2011, Federal Register (Volume 76, No. 32):

The application for authorization of these Nationwide Permits was submitted by the United States Army Corps of Engineers, CECW-CO-R, 441 G Street, NW, Washington, D.C. 20314-1000.

The discharges from the activities, if approved, would result in degradation to, or lowering of, the water quality of surface waters of the state, including wetlands, streams and lakes. Draft section 401 water quality certifications were prepared after reviewing the application in accordance with Chapters 3745-1 and 3745-32 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC). In accordance with OAC Rule 3745-1, an antidegradation review of the application has been conducted.

No exclusions or waivers apply or may be granted by the director of Ohio EPA, as outlined by OAC Rule 3745-1-05(D) (effective on May 1, 1998).

Starting January 13, 2012, Ohio EPA's draft certification of the nationwide permits may be inspected on Ohio EPA's Division of Surface Water website at www.epa.ohio.gov/dsw.

Ohio EPA will hold a public information session and public hearing relative to issues of lower water quality on February 27, 2012 at 3:30 p.m. at the Center for Excellence located on the sixth floor of Ohio EPA's offices at 50 West Town Street, Suite 700, Columbus, Ohio, 43215. The public hearing will end when all interested parties have had an opportunity to provide testimony related to the project.

All interested persons are entitled to attend or be represented and give written or oral comments on the proposed project. The purpose of the hearing is to obtain additional information that will be considered by Ohio EPA prior to any further action on the proposed application.

Persons wishing to be on Ohio EPA's interested parties mailing list for this project or submit written comments for Ohio EPA's consideration regarding the proposed reauthorization of the nationwide permits should do so electronically, in person, or by mail no later than the close of business on March 5, 2012.
