The applicant's proposed preferred alternative, if approved, would involve dredging 500,000 cubic yards of bottom sediment from the Federal navigation channel and placement of the dredged material on the Lake Erie bottom, below the ordinary high water mark (OHWM) at a designated disposal site. The applicant's proposed minimal degradation alternative, if approved, would involve dredging 300,000 cubic yards of bottom sediment from the Federal navigation channel and placement in the same location as the preferred alternative. The applicant's proposed non-degradation alternative, if approved, would have no direct impacts on waters of the state.

Discharges from the activity, if approved, would result in degradation to, or lowering of, the water quality of Lake Erie. Ohio EPA will review the application, and decide whether to grant or deny the application, in accordance with OAC Chapters 3745-1 and 3745-32.
