Notice is hereby given that the Director of Environmental Protection, under the authority of Ohio Revised Code Section 3704.03 has adopted amended rules 3745-31-34 and 3745-77-11 of the Administrative Code.

The intent of this rulemaking was to adopt an exemption for facilities that use Biomass as a fuel in their processes. This will make Ohio's rules equivalent in scope and intent to the federal Greenhouse Gas Tailoring Rules (as amended at 76 FR 43490, July 20, 2011). The intent of Ohio's rulemaking is to prevent potentially affected facilities from obtaining unnecessary permits prior to the July 1, 2012 permitting deadline.

A public hearing on this rule was held on February 8, 2012 in Columbus, Ohio. No comments or testimony was received on these rules. The Director's order of adoption was issued on Monday, March 12, 2012. The effective date of this rule is Thursday, March 22, 2012.

Public notice is hereby given that the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has received, on December 22, 2011, a request to approve an Urban Setting Designation for approximately 484 acres of land located around the Bridgestone America Technical Operations Center redevelopment Project and Firestone Park Area with approximate borders being Kenmore Blvd and Ohio Eire Canal to the east, Ira Avenue to the north, South Main Street to the west and West Wilbeth Road to the south. This request was submitted by Tomas J. Mignery, Burgess and Niple, Inc. on behalf of City of Akron.

Pursuant to Ohio Administrative Code 3745-300-10(D), Ohio's Voluntary Action Program (VAP) allows for the voluntary clean up of contaminated property in Ohio without the risk of state civil liability. Under VAP, ground water cleanup is required where contaminated ground water poses risks to the community or environment.

A USD may be requested for properties participating in the VAP when there is no current or anticipated future use of ground water by local residents for drinking, showering, bathing or cooking. In these areas, an approved USD would lower the cost of cleanup and promote economic redevelopment while still protecting public health and safety.

The Ohio EPA director may approve the request for a USD based on a demonstration by the certified professional that the USD requirements are met and an evaluation of existing or future uses of ground water in the area have been assessed.

Notice is hereby given that the Director of Environmental Protection is proposing to update water quality management plans, as required by Sections 303 and 208 of the Clean Water Act. These plans describe and promote efficient and comprehensive programs for controlling water pollution from point and nonpoint sources in a defined geographic area. This update includes updated 208 Plans from the following Areawide Councils of Governments:

- Eastgate Regional Council of Governments;
- Toledo Metropolitan Area Council of Governments;
- Ohio Kentucky Indiana Regional Council of Governments;
- Northeast Ohio Areawide Coordinating Agency;

Areawide Councils of Governments act as the lead planning agencies in 24 Ohio counties (those with large urban populations). The Areawide Agencies prepare and approve the 208 Plan in their counties. Pursuant to applicable regulations, the State of Ohio has authority to certify that the documents include the required plan elements, are consistent with one another, and are consistent with basin plans. Although the State of Ohio prepares and maintains the 208 Plan applicable in the remaining 64 counties, no updates to these counties are being considered at this time. The Governor then certifies the entire 208 Plan via submission to U.S. EPA for their approval.

The public comment period will run until **5:00 p.m. on May 9, 2012**. A public hearing on the proposed 208 Plan update will be held to consider public comments. This hearing will be held at **10:00 a.m. on May 9, 2012** at the following location:
