**ISSUANCE OF A PROPOSED NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION

SESSION / HEARING**

Notice is hereby given that on March 8, 2012, the Ohio EPA issued a proposed National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit modification, NPDES 2IN00136*BD, to Sunny Farms Landfill LLC, 12500 West County Road 18, Fostoria, Ohio 44830. The proposed NPDES permit modification, if issued as a final permit, would add one outfall location to the existing permit. "Proposed Actions" are written statements of the Director's intent with respect to the issuance, denial, etc. of a permit, license, order, etc. Interested persons may submit written comments regarding proposed actions.

The discharges for the facility, if approved, would result in degradation to, or lowering of, the water quality of an unnamed tributary of Wolf Creek, Wolf Creek and subsequently the Sandusky River. However, the chemical-specific water quality criteria developed to protect aquatic life and human health, set forth in Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) 3745-1-07, will not be exceeded.

In accordance with Ohio Revised Code (ORC) 3734.05 and OAC 3745-1-05, Ohio EPA will provide an opportunity for public comment concerning this project. Comments received shall be considered by the director before the proposed action is issued final. A Public Hearing will be held on Wednesday, May 9, 2012, at the Fostoria Municipal Court, 213 South Main Street, Fostoria, Ohio 44830. The meeting will start at 6:30 p.m. The public hearing will end when everyone in attendance has had an opportunity to provide testimony related to the project.

All interested persons are entitled to attend or be represented and give written or oral comments on the proposed action. The purpose of the hearing is to obtain additional information that will be considered by the Director of Ohio EPA prior to further action on the proposed action.
