Public notice is hereby given that the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) Division of Surface Water (DSW) has issued a draft general National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit to renew coverage to the Bulk Fuel Storage Facilities permit.

The permit covers primarily storm water discharges from bulk fuel storage facilities to waters of the State of Ohio. The permit covers facilities that include storage tanks and/or pipelines which provide storage or conveyance for crude oil, petroleum products or other fuel materials such as ethanol or biodiesel and may also cover certain process waste waters such as tank water draws, if it is adequately treated. The permit does not cover any discharges that the Director of the Ohio EPA has determined to be contributing to a violation of a Water Quality Standard (WQS) as determined in Ohio Administrative Code, Chapter 3745-1.

Public notice is hereby given that the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) Division of Surface Water (DSW) has received an application for, and has begun to consider a Clean Water Act Section 401 water quality certification for a project to repair a 30 inch steel natural gas pipeline (TPL-15) which was completed in December 2011 under emergency circumstances. The application was submitted by the East Ohio Gas Company. The project is located southeast of the intersection of Rochester Road (County Hwy 402) and Mountz Road (Township Hwy 808). As required by the Antidegradation Rule, rule 3745-1-05 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC), three alternatives have been submitted for the project. The applicant's proposed preferred alternative would impact 0.172 acres of wetland, with approximate construction limits of 50 ft. X 150 ft. within the utility right-of-way corridor. The applicant's proposed minimal degradation alternative would impact 0.043 acres of wetland, with approximate construction limits of 25 ft. X 75 ft. within the utility right-of-way corridor. The applicant's proposed non-degradation alternative, if approved, would have no direct impacts on waters of the state.

Discharges from the activity would result in degradation to, or lowering of, the water quality of Sandy Creek headwaters in the Tuscarawas watershed. Ohio EPA will review the application in accordance with OAC Chapters 3745-1 and 3745-32. In accordance with OAC rule 3745-1-05, an antidegradation review of the application will be conducted. All three proposed alternatives will be considered during the review process. No exclusions or waivers, as outlined by OAC rule 3745-1-05, apply or may be granted.
