WESTVIEW PROJECT AREA, DAYTON**

Public notice is hereby given that the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) received a request on December 9, 2011, to approve an Urban Setting Designation (USD) for approximately 395 acres of land located in west Dayton. Properties within the proposed USD include the former Delphi Home Avenue facility, associated with the Dayton Aviation Heritage Project, the former McCall Printing property and the former Nibco Foundry. This request was submitted by Ohio Voluntary Action Program (VAP) Certified Professional (CP) Steve Gross, Hull & Associates, Inc., on behalf of the city of Dayton.

Pursuant to Ohio Administrative Code 3745-300-10(D), the VAP allows for the voluntary cleanup of contaminated property in Ohio without the risk of state civil liability. Under the VAP, ground water cleanup is required where contaminated ground water poses risks to the community or environment.

A USD may be requested for properties participating in the VAP when there is no current or anticipated future use of ground water by local residents for drinking, showering, bathing or cooking. In these areas, an approved USD can lower the cost of cleanup and promote economic redevelopment while still protecting public health and safety.

The Ohio EPA director may approve the request for a USD based on a demonstration by the certified professional that the USD requirements are met and an evaluation of existing or future uses of ground water in the area have been assessed.

Public notice is hereby given that the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) Division of Surface Water (DSW) has received an application for, and has begun to consider whether to issue or deny, a Clean Water Act Section 401 certification for a surface coal mine, auger coal mine, and reclamation project on a 178.2 acres site. The application was submitted by Oxford Mining Company, LLC. The project is located north and south of Lodge Hill Road (Township Road 334), Union, Richland, and Wheeling Townships, Belmont County, Ohio. The Pittsburgh District of the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Number for this project is LRP-2012-175. The Ohio EPA ID Number for this project is 123925.

As required by the Antidegradation Rule, three alternatives have been submitted for the project. The applicant's proposed preferred degradation alternative, if approved, would impact 4,137 feet of intermittent stream, and 350 feet of ephemeral stream, (4,487 feet total), and 0.17 acres of category 1 wetland and 0.46 acres of category 2 wetland (0.63 acres total). The proposed minimal degradation alternative if approved, would impact 1,337 feet of intermittent stream, and 335 feet of ephemeral stream, (2,033 feet total), and 0.17 acres of category 1 wetlands and 0.40 acres of category 2 wetlands (0.57 acres total). The applicant's proposed non-degradation alternative, if approved, would have no direct impacts on streams or wetlands.

The discharges from the activity, if approved, would result in degradation to, or lowering of, the water quality of the Wheeling Creek watershed. The review of the application will be conducted, and a decision whether to grant or deny the application will be made, in accordance with Chapters 3745-1 and 3745-32 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC). In accordance with OAC 3745-1-05, an antidegradation review of the application will be conducted before deciding whether to allow a lowering of the water quality. Other alternatives resulting in lesser or no degradation, or lowering of water quality, will be considered by Ohio EPA during the review process.

No exclusions or waivers, as outlined by Paragraph 3745-1-05 (D) of the Antidegradation Rule (effective as of May 1, 1998), apply or may be granted by the Director of Ohio EPA.

On June 13, 2012, Ohio EPA issued a draft director initiated permit modification to Cytec Industries, Inc.'s (Cytec) hazardous waste facility installation and operation permit (Permit) for its facility at 1405 Greene Street, Marietta, Ohio 45750. The EPA Identification Number for this facility is OHD 004 341 509.

Why is Ohio EPA Initiating a Modification to Cytec's Permit?

Cytec is a former specialty chemical manufacturing plant that is permitted to conduct closure, post closure, and corrective action activities at the facility. This permit modification will authorize Cytec to undertake certain remedies (implement approved corrective measures) to cleanup soil and ground water contamination on their property at the North landfill, East Storage Pad, Concrete Tank Saddles, Drainage Swale and Duck Creek. The proposed permit modification language is included in Module E-Corrective Action Requirements Section of the draft permit, and will become an enforceable term and condition of the permit.
