The Ohio EPA director may approve the request for a USD based on a demonstration by the certified professional that the USD requirements are met and an evaluation of existing or future uses of ground water in the area have been assessed.

Public notice is hereby given that the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) Division of Surface Water (DSW) has received an application for, and has begun to consider whether to issue or deny, a Clean Water Act Section 401 water quality certification for a project to develop a multi-use office and industrial complex serving Chesapeake Energy and its subsidiary companies. The application was submitted by Hammontree & Associates. The project is located on Beck Avenue, Louisville, OH.
