Public notice is hereby given that the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) Division of Surface Water (DSW) has received an application for, and has begun to consider whether to issue or deny, a Clean Water Act Section 401 water quality certification for construction of the TUS-39-24.22 project. The project is an improvement to 0.25 miles of State Route (SR) 39 in Warren Township, Tuscarawas County, Ohio. The project will construct a 1.5:1 reinforced slope north of SR 39. This slope correction will be constructed using the centerline alignment of SR 39. The slope rehabilitation will utilize benching and geogrid material in order to stabilize the embankment with the 1.5:1 slope. The application was submitted by The Ohio Department of Transportation, 1980 West Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio 43223.

The purpose of this project is to repair a roadway embankment failure in order to maintain a safe and efficient highway facility. The embankment failure is the result of an over-steepened roadway slope and unstable soils on the north side of SR 39. This project will involve the stabilization of 471 linear feet of perennial Stream 1 by placing rock channel protection along a portion of its southern bank. In addition, two culverts will be replaced along SR 39; one on Stream 3 (intermittent) and one on Stream 4 (ephemeral). The new impact to Stream 3 is 61 feet and the new impact to Stream 4 is 32 feet. Including the previous culvert and rock channel protection, the total impact to Stream 3 is 111 feet and Stream 4 is 64. Lastly, 0.35 acre of modified Category 2 wetland will be impacted. This project is within the Tuscarawas River Watershed (14-digit HUC 05040001080010). The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Project Number is 2011-00618-TUS and the Ohio EPA SWIMS ID Number is 124018. The ODOT reference number for this project is TUS-39-24.22 (PID 83378).

As required by the Antidegradation Rule, rule 3745-1-05 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC), three alternatives have been submitted for the project. The applicant proposes to build the minimal degradation alternative. The preferred alternative (not selected), would involve impacts to a total of 1,326 linear feet of three jurisdictional streams and 0.54 acre of modified Category 2 jurisdictional wetlands. The applicant's proposed minimal degradation alternative (selected), would impact a total of 564 linear feet of three jurisdictional streams and 0.35 acre of modified Category 2 jurisdictional wetland. This reduction of impacts is the result of using engineered geogrid materials to construct a proposed slope of 1.5:1 rather than 2:1 therefore reducing the encroachment into wetlands and streams. The applicant's proposed non-degradation alternative, if approved, would have no impacts on waters of the state or U.S., but would not meet the purpose and need for the project.

Ohio EPA will review the application, and decide whether to grant or deny the application, in accordance with OAC Chapters 3745-1 and 3745-32. In accordance with OAC rule 3745-1-05, an antidegradation review of the application will be conducted before deciding whether to allow a lowering of water quality. All three proposed alternatives will be considered during the review process. No exclusions or waivers, as outlined by OAC rule 3745-1-05, apply or may be granted.
