The Director's action in this matter is pursuant to the procedural requirements of Ohio Revised Code Chapter 119 and is based upon the record of the public hearing conducted by Ohio EPA on August 21, 2012, and comments received during the public comment period.

You are hereby notified that this action of the Director is final and may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission pursuant to Section 3745.04 of the Ohio Revised Code. The appeal must be in writing and set forth the action complained of and the grounds upon which the appeal is based. The appeal must be filed with the Commission within thirty (30) days after notice of the Director's action. The appeal must be accompanied by a filing fee of \$70.00, made payable to "Ohio Treasurer Josh Mandel," which the Commission, in its discretion, may reduce if by affidavit you demonstrate that payment of the full amount of the fee would cause extreme hardship. Notice of the filing of the appeal shall be filed with the Director within three (3) days of filing with the Commission. Request for Comment on Proposed Rules

Notice is hereby given that the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency has proposed new rules in Chapter 3745-7 (Operator Certification) of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC). The new rules establish a program under which organizations can apply to become approved examination providers for water and wastewater operators wanting to become state-certified. The draft rules would require the examination provider to conduct computerized examinations in multiple locations and multiple times per year. DDAGW would continue to hold state-sponsored examinations twice per year and give operators the choice of whether they would like to take the computerized examination offered by the approved examination provider or the traditional state examination.

A public hearing pursuant to §119.03 of the Ohio Revised Code will be conducted on November 13, 2012, beginning at 10:30 a.m. in Conference Room C at the Ohio EPA, Lazarus Government Center, 50 West Town Street, Columbus, Ohio. All interested persons are entitled to attend or be represented and give their written or oral comments on this proposed rule-making. A presiding officer will be present until all interested persons have been heard.

To facilitate scheduling of oral presentations, persons intending to give testimony at the hearing should ensure that Ohio EPA receives notice of such intent by 5:00 p.m. on November 12, 2012. Persons who provide Ohio EPA with prior notice will be heard ahead of persons who register at the hearing. **All visitors to Ohio EPA must register at the Security desk in the lobby upon arrival. Please bring photo identification (such as a valid driver's license). For security reasons, visitors are required to wear their badge at all times while in the building.
