The project is located at 33665 Chester Rd, SW of the jct with Lear Nagel Road, City of Avon, Lorain County (41°29'5.146"; 81°59'30.155"). The Corps of Engineers Project # is 2011-00998. As required by the Antidegradation Rule, rule 3745-1-05 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC), three alternatives have been submitted for the project. The applicant's proposed preferred alternative, if approved, would result in permanent impacts to 2.86 acres of Category 2 forested wetlands. The applicant's proposed minimal degradation alternative, if approved, would result in permanent impacts to 2.59 acres of Category 2 forested wetlands. The applicant's proposed non-degradation alternative, if approved, would have no direct impacts on waters of the state.

Proposed compensatory mitigation for the wetlands impacts is purchase of 4.5 acres of category 2 forested wetland credit at the Edison Woods Mitigation Bank and 1.7 acres of forested wetland credit at the Castalia Quarry Mitigation Bank.

Discharges from the activity, if approved, would result in degradation to, or lowering of, the water quality of the Black River. Ohio EPA will review the application, and decide whether to grant or deny the application, in accordance with OAC Chapters 3745-1 and 3745-32. In accordance with OAC rule 3745-1-05, an antidegradation review of the application will be conducted before deciding whether to allow a lowering of water quality. All three proposed alternatives will be considered during the review process. No exclusions or waivers, as outlined by OAC rule 3745-1-05, apply or may be granted.

Both the State of Ohio and the Defendants reserve the right to withdraw or alter the proposed Consent Order based on comments received during the public comment period.
