This action of the Director is final and may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission (the "Commission") pursuant to ORC 3745.04. The appeal must be in writing and set forth the action complained of and the grounds upon which the appeal is based. The appeal must be filed with the Commission within thirty (30) days after notice of the action. The appeal must be accompanied by a filing fee of \$70.00, made payable to "Treasurer, State of Ohio", which the Commission, in its discretion, may reduce if by affidavit it is demonstrated that payment of the full amount of the fee would cause extreme hardship. Notice of the filing of the appeal shall be filed with the Director within three (3) days of filing with the Commission. NOTICE OF RECEIPT OF 401 APPLICATION**

Public notice is hereby given that the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) Division of Surface Water (DSW) has received an application for, and has begun to consider whether to issue or deny, a Clean Water Act Section 401 water quality certification to expand the Cuyahoga Community College, Westlake Campus located at 31001 Clemens Road, Westlake, Cuyahoga County (41°28'11.446"; 81°57'45.216"). The proposed project will impact approximately 9 acres of the total 33.1 acre parcel. The application was submitted by Cuyahoga Community College, 700 Carnegie Avenue, Cleveland, OH 44115. The Corps of Engineers Project # is 2009-01416. The Ohio EPA ID Number for this project is 113795.

As required by the Antidegradation Rule, rule 3745-1-05 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC), three alternatives have been submitted for the project. The applicant's proposed preferred alternative, if approved, would result in permanent impacts to 2.57 acres of Category 2 forested wetlands, and 1,193 linear feet (LF) of ephemeral stream. The applicant's proposed minimal degradation alternative, if approved, would result in permanent impacts to 1.02 acres of Category 2 forested wetlands and 1,193 LF of ephemeral stream. The applicant's proposed non-degradation alternative, if approved, would have no direct impacts on waters of the state.

Proposed compensatory mitigation for the wetlands impacts is purchase of 2.6 acres of category 2 forested wetland credit at an Ohio EPA approved Mitigation Bank and on-site enhancement of 1,747 LF of avoided stream.

Discharges from the activity, if approved, would result in degradation to, or lowering of, the water quality in the Porter Creek watershed. Ohio EPA will review the application, and decide whether to grant or deny the application, in accordance with OAC Chapters 3745-1 and 3745-32. In accordance with OAC rule 3745-1-05, an antidegradation review of the application will be conducted before deciding whether to allow a lowering of water quality. All three proposed alternatives will be considered during the review process. No exclusions or waivers, as outlined by OAC rule 3745-1-05, apply or may be granted.
