PROPOSED CONSENT ORDER**

The Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) and Cardington Yutaka Technologies, Inc. ("CYT") have entered into a proposed Consent Order, Case Number 2012 CV 0043. The proposed Consent Order would require CYT to immediately comply with the requirements of Ohio Revised Code Chapter 6111 by completing permit to install applications, completing an environmental audit, making available records of waste shipped offsite, installing and maintaining flow meters, and applying for an indirect discharge permit or an NPDES permit. CYT is an auto-parts manufacturing facility located at 575 West Main Street, Cardington, Morrow County, Ohio.

The proposed Consent Order also requires CYT to pay a five hundred thousand dollar (\$500,000) civil penalty.

Ohio EPA Issues Notice of Tentative Decision to Issue a Variance

On December 5, 2012, the director of Ohio EPA issued a draft notice tentatively granting a variance to Skye Metals Recovery, Inc. (Skye) for its facility located at 110 Blue Knob Road, Building 1D, Marietta, Ohio 45750 in Washington County, pursuant to Ohio Administrative Code rule 3745-50-26. If issued as a final variance, certain materials that Skye handles would not be wastes under Ohio's hazardous waste laws. The Agency is proposing to issue this variance because Skye recycles wastes, and uses and manages these materials more like products than wastes. Sky will operate and maintain a metals recycling facility. The metals of interest to Skye associated with this variance are nickel, cobalt, and molybdenum. Skye will accept metal hydroxide bearing filter cake generated from the dewatering of sludge generated from the treatment of wastewater from electroplating operations, and spent hydrotreating or hydrorefining catalyst from the petroleum refining operations for reclaiming. Once received, Skye recycles the filter cake and spent catalyst by concentrating the levels of the metals using a calciner. The product is sold to the steelmaking industry for use in making steel and other alloys. Without this variance, Skye's activities would be regulated as hazardous waste management activities and Skye would need a hazardous waste facility installation and operation permit.

When issued, this variance will allow Skye to store and process the electroplating wastewater filter cake and spent catalyst from petroleum refining without obtaining a hazardous waste permit. The draft variance contains the conditions under which the facility must operate if the variance receives final approval. To issue this draft variance, Ohio EPA evaluated the request considering the factors in rule 3745-50-24 of the Ohio Administrative Code relevant to the modification requested.
