NOTICE OF RECEIPT OF 401 APPLICATION**

Public notice is hereby given that the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) Division of Surface Water (DSW) has received an application for, and has begun to consider whether to issue or deny, a Clean Water Act Section 401 water quality certification for a project to remove the Monument Avenue low dam, and install two in-stream grade control structures and improve one access point on the Great Miami River. The application was submitted by Five Rivers MetroParks. The project is located at between the Monument Avenue and Riverside Street bridges in Dayton Ohio (39.765°N, 84.196°W). The Huntington District Corps of Engineers Public Notice Number for this project is LRH-2012-311-GMR. The Ohio EPA ID Number for this project is 134066.

As required by the Antidegradation Rule, rule 3745-1-05 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC), three alternatives have been submitted for the project. The applicant's proposed preferred alternative, if approved, would permanently impact approximately 910 linear feet, and temporarily impact 3,050 linear feet of the Great Miami River. The applicant's proposed minimal degradation alternative, if approved, would permanently impact approximately 740 linear feet, and temporarily impact 2,400 of the Great Miami River. The applicant's proposed non-degradation alternative, if approved, would have no direct impacts on waters of the state.

Discharges from the activity, if approved, would result in degradation to, or lowering of, the water quality of Great Miami River. Ohio EPA will review the application, and decide whether to grant or deny the application, in accordance with OAC Chapters 3745-1 and 3745-32. In accordance with OAC rule 3745-1-05, an antidegradation review of the application will be conducted before deciding whether to allow a lowering of water quality. All three proposed alternatives will be considered during the review process. No exclusions or waivers, as outlined by OAC rule 3745-1-05, apply or may be granted.
