ISSUANCE OF A DIRECTOR INITIATED DRAFT PERMIT MODIFICATION**

On August 29, 2013, the director of Ohio EPA issued a Director Initiated Draft Permit Modification to IRG Warren I, LLC and Delphi Automotive Systems, LLC (Delphi) for its facility located on North River Road at Larchmont Avenue, Warren, Ohio in Trumbull County. The Ohio EPA ID number is OHD 000 817 346. In 2011, the facility was divided into two parcels. One parcel was sold to IRG Warren I, LLC of Downey, California (IRG). The remaining parcel was retained by Delphi. Delphi started operations in 1954. Known then as Packard Electric, the facility was a division of General Motors Corporation. As a result of waste disposal practices conducted at the site, contaminated soil and ground water remains on the property. The purpose of this director's initiated modification is to select a remedy/corrective measure to address contaminated soil and ground water at the site. This draft action replaces a July 2012 draft action.
