This excavated material will be pushed via dozer to the east of the proposed ski course which will create a new island or essentially connect the two existing small islands into one larger island. Approximately 1,600 cubic yards of this excavated material will be placed below the ordinary high water level of Lake Milton. The applicant's proposed minimal degradation alternative, if approved, would lower the turn-island area of Lake Milton by an average 1' by excavating 1,000 cubic yards of material within the proposed turn-island boundary. This excavated material will be pushed via dozer to the east of the proposed ski course which will create a new island. Approximately 600 cubic yards of this excavated material will be placed below the ordinary high water level of Lake Milton. The applicant's proposed non-degradation alternative, if approved, would have no direct impacts on waters of the state.

Discharges from the activity, if approved, would result in degradation to, or lowering of, the water quality of Lake Milton. Ohio EPA will review the application, and decide whether to grant or deny the application, in accordance with OAC Chapters 3745-1 and 3745-32. In accordance with OAC rule 3745-1-05, an antidegradation review of the application will be conducted before deciding whether to allow a lowering of water quality. All three proposed alternatives will be considered during the review process. No exclusions or waivers, as outlined by OAC rule 3745-1-05, apply or may be granted.
