Public Notice: Final Rulemaking Governing Operator Certification Requirements

Notice is hereby given that the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency, Division of Drinking and Ground Waters (DDAGW) adopted revisions to rule 3745-7-02 in the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) establishing operator certification requirements for the state of Ohio. The revisions to this rule allow an operator who holds a Class A certificate and has passed the Class I water supply certification examination but does not have the required experience to be the operator of record for certain Class I systems if specific conditions are met. This rule has been reviewed pursuant to the five year rule review requirements of Section 119.032 of the Revised Code.

The Director of Environmental Protection, after considering public comment, adopted this rule in final form, pursuant to Section 6109.04 of the Ohio Revised Code. The Director's order of adoption was issued on October 20, 2014. The effective date of the amended rule will be October 30, 2014 in accordance with Section 119.04(A) of the Revised Code.

You are hereby notified that this action of the Director is final and may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission pursuant to Section 3745.04 of the Ohio Revised Code. The appeal must be in writing and set forth the action complained of and the grounds upon which the appeal is based. The appeal must be filed with the Commission within thirty (30) days after notice of the Director's action. The appeal must be accompanied by a filing fee of \$70.00, made payable to "Ohio Treasurer Josh Mandel," which the Commission, in its discretion, may reduce if by affidavit you demonstrate that payment of the full amount of the fee would cause extreme hardship. Notice of the filing of the appeal shall be filed with the Director within three (3) days of filing with the Commission. **Ohio EPA Approves Modification of Authorization to Fill, Grade, Excavate, Build,
Drill or Mine Landfill at
Calgon Carbon Corporation, Columbus, Ohio**

On October 20, 2014, the Director of Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) issued a modification of an Ohio Administrative Code § 3745-27-13 authorization to URS Corporation and Calgon Carbon Corporation to engage in filling, grading, excavating, and drilling activities at the Calgon Carbon Corporation property located at 835 North Cassady Avenue in Columbus, Ohio (Franklin County). The authorization involves environmental monitoring and remediation at the location of a former landfill. The modification changes plans for borrow and fill activities. The request was made by URS Corporation on behalf of Calgon Carbon Corporation and the activities will be conducted by URS Corporation.

The request was required because the area is a landfill where waste material was disposed prior to July 29, 1976.

You are hereby notified that this action of the Director is final and may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission (Commission) pursuant to Section 3745.04 of the Ohio Revised Code. The appeal must be in writing and set forth the action complained of and the grounds upon which the appeal is based. The appeal must be filed with the Commission within 30 days after notice of the Director's action. The appeal must be accompanied by a filing fee of \$70.00, made payable to "Ohio Treasurer," which the Commission, in its discretion, may reduce if by affidavit you demonstrate that payment of the full amount of the fee would cause extreme hardship. Notice of the filing of the appeal shall be filed with the Director within three days of filing with the Commission. Ohio EPA requests that a copy of the appeal be served upon the Ohio Attorney General's Office, Environmental Enforcement Section. NOTICE OF RECEIPT OF ISOLATED WETLAND PERMIT
APPLICATION (LEVEL 2)**

Public notice is hereby given that the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) Division of Surface Water (DSW) has received an application for, and has begun to consider whether to issue or deny, an Isolated Wetland Permit (Level 2) for a project to construct a landfill, impacting 2.1 acres of Category 1 wetlands. The application was submitted by Grant Milliron, Frontier Recycling and Disposal, LLC. The project is located at the southeast corner of the intersection of Noble Road East and State Route 13 in Butler Township, Richland County. The Ohio EPA Number for this project is 144489.

The review of the application will be conducted, and a decision whether to grant or deny the application will be made, in accordance with Ohio Revised Code (ORC) Sections 6111.02 to 6111.028 and other applicable provisions of state laws. Other alternatives as proposed by the applicant resulting in less adverse impact to the isolated wetland ecosystem, will be considered by Ohio EPA during the review process.
