The proposed revision the Agency is considering is the removal of the thallium non-drink human health water quality criterion applicable to the Ohio River drainage basin.

The public comment period will run until **5:00 p.m. on May 20, 2014**. A public hearing on these proposed rule amendments will be held to consider public comments in accordance with Section 119.03 of the Ohio Revised Code. This hearing will be held in **Conference Room B at the Ohio EPA Central Office, 50 West Town Street, Suite 700, Columbus, Ohio at 10:30 a.m. on May 20, 2014**. The applicant's proposed preferred alternative, if approved, would impact 1,940 linear feet of three perennial streams, 1,038 linear feet of three intermittent streams, 4.47 acres of two non-forested category 1 wetlands, and 0.713 acres of two jurisdictional ditches. The applicant's proposed minimal degradation alternative, if approved, would impact 1,060 linear feet of three perennial streams, 1,038 linear feet of three intermittent streams, 4.47 acres of two non-forested category 1 wetlands, and 0.544 acres of two jurisdictional ditches. The applicant's proposed non-degradation alternative, if approved, would have no direct impacts on waters of the state.

Discharges from the activity, if approved, would result in degradation to, or lowering of, the water quality of the Blanchard River, Dalzell Ditch, Oil Ditch, N.M.
