**Public Notice: Final Rulemaking on Primary Drinking Water Standards and Adoption of Revisions to Policy, “Clarification of Public Water System Definition.”**

Notice is hereby given that the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency, Division of Drinking and Ground Waters (DDAGW) adopted revisions to rules 3745-81-01 and 3745-81-76 in the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) establishing primary drinking water standards for the state of Ohio. These rules have been reviewed pursuant to the five year rule review requirements of Section 119.032 of the Revised Code.

These rules include definitions in the primary drinking water standards in Chapter 3745-81-01 of the OAC and water source designation of public water systems (PWS). The DDAGW made revisions to OAC rule 3745-81-01 to clarify the definition of a PWS by setting default populations, such as per service connection or dwelling for communities and for non-communities. Additionally, revisions to rule 3745-81-76 of the Administrative Code were made. The revisions allow DDAGW to designate the majority of sources by rule with an allowance for the Director to designate a well as surface water under certain conditions.

The Director of Environmental Protection, after considering public comment, adopted these rules in final form, pursuant to Section 6109.04 of the Ohio Revised Code. The Director’s order of adoption was issued on June 9, 2014. The effective date of the amended rules will be June 19, 2014 in accordance with Section 119.04(A) of the Revised Code.

You are hereby notified that this action of the Director is final and may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission pursuant to Section 3745.04 of the Ohio Revised Code. The appeal must be in writing and set forth the action complained of and the grounds upon which the appeal is based. The appeal must be filed with the Commission within thirty (30) days after notice of the Director’s action. The appeal must be accompanied by a filing fee of \$70.00, made payable to “Ohio Treasurer Josh Mandel,” which the Commission, in its discretion, may reduce if by affidavit you demonstrate that payment of the full amount of the fee would cause extreme hardship. Notice of the filing of the appeal shall be filed with the Director within three (3) days of filing with the Commission. Ohio EPA requests that a copy of the appeal be served upon the Ohio Attorney General’s Office, Environmental Enforcement Section.
