The application was submitted by the Ohio Department of Transportation. The project is located three miles north of the City of Marietta on State Route 821 in Muskingum Township, Washington County. The Huntington District Corps of Engineers Public Notice Number for this project is LRH-2013-599-OHR. The Ohio EPA ID Number for this project is 134238.

As required by the Antidegradation Rule, 3745-1-05, of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC), three alternatives have been submitted for the project. The applicant's proposed preferred alternative, if approved, would impact 130 linear feet of intermittent stream, 2125 linear feet of ephemeral stream, and 0.064 acre of category 1 wetland. The applicant's proposed minimal degradation alternative, if approved, would impact 200 linear feet of intermittent stream, 1960 linear feet of ephemeral stream, and 0.064 acre of category 1 wetland. The applicant's proposed non-degradation alternative, if approved, would have no direct impacts on waters of the state.

Discharges from the activity, if approved, would result in degradation to, or lowering of, the water quality of seven unnamed tributaries of New Year's Creek and two associated wetlands.
