NOTICE OF RECEIPT OF 401 APPLICATION**

Public notice is hereby given that the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) Division of Surface Water (DSW) has received an application for, and has begun to consider whether to issue or deny, a Clean Water Act Section 401 water quality certification for a project to recover the Meigs Creek (No. 9) and Wayneburg (No.11) coal seams by surface mining. The application was submitted by Oxford Mining Company, LLC. The project is located in sections 25 and 31 in Union Township, Belmont County, Ohio. The Huntington District Corps of Engineers Public Notice Number for this project is LRH-2013-435-UT Stillwater Creek. The Ohio EPA ID Number for this project is 144336.

As required by the Antidegradation Rule, rule 3745-1-05 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC), three alternatives have been submitted for the project. The applicant's proposed preferred alternative, if approved, would encompass 265.1 acres. Jurisdictional waters to be impacted under the preferred alternative include 1,564 linear feet of intermittent stream and 362 linear feet of ephemeral stream. The applicant's proposed minimal degradation alternative, if approved, would encompass 234.6 acres. Jurisdictional waters to be impacted under the minimal degradation alternative include 1,300 linear feet of intermittent stream and 362 linear feet of ephemeral stream. The applicant's proposed non-degradation alternative, if approved, would have no direct impacts on waters of the state.

Discharges from the activity, if approved, would result in degradation to, or lowering of, the water quality of unnamed tributaries to Stillwater Creek. Ohio EPA will review the application, and decide whether to grant or deny the application, in accordance with OAC Chapters 3745-1 and 3745-32. In accordance with OAC rule 3745-1-05, an antidegradation review of the application will be conducted before deciding whether to allow a lowering of water quality. All three proposed alternatives will be considered during the review process. No exclusions or waivers, as outlined by OAC rule 3745-1-05, apply or may be granted.
