ISSUANCE OF A DRAFT RENEWAL PERMIT**

On July 11, 2014, Ohio EPA issued to Cytec Industries, Inc. a draft renewal of the hazardous waste installation and operation permit (Permit) for the facility at 1405 Greene Street, Marietta, Ohio 45750. The EPA Identification number for this facility is OHD 004 341 509. Cytec Industries, Inc. (Cytec) owns and operates the closed facility under a permit recognized by Ohio EPA. The facility is a former specialty chemical plant that operated for over 90 years and manufactured dyes, DDT, rubber additives, UV absorbers, and a rocket fuel regulator, among other specialty products. Manufacturing and routine hazardous waste acceptance ceased in December 2002. As a result of waste disposal practices conducted at the site, contaminated soil and ground water remains on the property.

The purpose of this permit renewal is to allow Cytec to continue its corrective action activities to clean up soil and ground water contamination on the property and to continue post-closure activities. The 45 day public comment period begins on July 11, 2014 and ends on August 25, 2014. A public meeting will be held on August 12 at 6pm the Marietta Public Library Meeting Room located at 615 Fifth Street in Marietta for comments concerning the draft renewal Permit.
