**Public Notice: Final Rulemaking on Water Source Designation Rule**

Notice is hereby given that the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency, Division of Drinking and Ground Waters (DDAGW) adopted revisions to rule 3745-81-76 in the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) establishing primary drinking water standards for the state of Ohio. This rule was reviewed pursuant to the five year rule review requirements of Section 119.032 of the Revised Code.

Rule 3745-81-76 of the Administrative Code was previously adopted with revisions on June 9, 2014. The rule was withdrawn and refiled with a correction. The revisions to rule 3745-81-76 of the Administrative Code remain the same, allowing DDAGW to designate the majority of sources by rule with an allowance for the Director to designate a well as surface water under certain conditions.

The Director of Environmental Protection, after considering public comment, adopted these rules in final form, pursuant to Section 6109.04 of the Ohio Revised Code. The Director's order of adoption was issued on July 21, 2014. The effective date of the amended rules will be August 1, 2014 in accordance with Section 119.04(A) of the Revised Code.

NOTICE OF RECEIPT OF 401 APPLICATION AND PUBLIC HEARING**

Public notice is hereby given that the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) Division of Surface Water (DSW) has received an application for, and has begun to consider whether to issue or deny, a Clean Water Act Section 401 water quality certification for a project to remove the Ballville Dam. The application was submitted by the Mayor of the City of Fremont, Jim Ellis. The project is located at approximately river mile 18 of the Sandusky River, Ballville Township, Sandusky County. The Buffalo District Corps of Engineers Public Notice Number for this project is 2011-00046. The Ohio EPA ID Number for this project is 144364.

As required by the Anti-degradation Rule, rule 3745-1-05 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC), three alternatives have been submitted for the project. The applicant's proposed preferred alternative, if approved, would remove the Ballville Dam, stabilize an existing seawall, and install an ice control structure. The preferred alternative would impact 1,166 linear feet of warm water habitat stream and 0.67 acres of category 3 wetland. The applicant's proposed minimal degradation alternative, if approved, would repair the Ballville Dam and stabilize the existing seawall. The minimal degradation alternative would impact 230 linear feet of warm water habitat stream and 0.016 acres of category 3 wetland. The applicant's proposed non-degradation alternative, if approved, would have no direct impacts on waters of the state.

Discharges from the activity, if approved, would result in degradation to, or lowering of, the water quality of the Sandusky River and adjacent wetlands. Ohio EPA will review the application, and decide whether to grant or deny the application, in accordance with OAC Chapters 3745-1 and 3745-32. In accordance with OAC rule 3745-1-05, an anti-degradation review of the application will be conducted before deciding whether to allow a lowering of water quality. All three proposed alternatives will be considered during the review process. No exclusions or waivers, as outlined by OAC rule 3745-1-05, apply or may be granted.

Ohio EPA will hold a public information session and public hearing relative to issues of lower water quality on August 21, 2014 at 6:00 p.m. at The Neeley Center, Terra State Community College, 2830 Napoleon Road, Fremont, OH 43420. The public hearing will end when all interested parties have had an opportunity to provide testimony related to the project.

All interested persons are entitled to attend or be represented and give written or oral comments on the proposed project. The purpose of the hearing is to obtain additional information that will be considered by Ohio EPA prior to any further action on the

application.

Ohio EPA will continue to accept written comments on the application through the close of business on August 28, 2014. Comments received after this date may not be considered as part of the official record of the hearing.
