Public notice is hereby given that the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) has received, on July 30, 2014, a request to approve an Urban Setting Designation for approximately 5.311 acres of land, located at 611 Wilbeth Rd., Akron. This request was submitted by Ron Clark with Brownfield Restoration Group, LLC on behalf of Katz Cousins, LLC.

Pursuant to Ohio Administrative Code 3745-300-10(D), Ohio's Voluntary Action Program (VAP) allows for the voluntary cleanup of contaminated property in Ohio without the risk of state civil liability. Under VAP, ground water cleanup is required where contaminated ground water poses risks to the community or environment.

A USD may be requested when there is no current or anticipated future use of ground water by local residents for drinking, showering, bathing, cooking, or other potable purposes on or immediately adjacent to the USD property boundary. In these areas, an approved USD would lower the cost of cleanup and promote economic redevelopment, while still protecting public health and safety.

Ohio EPA's director may approve the request for a USD based on a demonstration by the certified professional that the USD requirements, set forth in OAC 3745-300-10(C), are met and an evaluation of all existing or future uses of ground water in the area have been considered and assessed.

NOTICE OF RECEIPT OF 401 APPLICATION AND PUBLIC HEARING**

Public notice is hereby given that the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) Division of Surface Water (DSW) has received an application for, and has begun to consider whether to issue or deny, a Clean Water Act Section 401 water quality certification for a project to construct phases 2 and 3 of the Portsmouth Bypass connecting US 23 north of Lucasville to US 52 near Wheelersburg, in Scioto County, OH (38.887517, -82.951070). The application was submitted by the Ohio Department of Transportation. The Huntington District Corps of Engineers Public Notice Number for this project is 2011-00646-OHR. The Ohio EPA ID Number for this project is 134161.

As required by the Antidegradation Rule, 3745-1-05, of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC), three alternatives have been submitted for the project. The applicant's proposed preferred alternative, if approved, would impact: 2.079 acres of seventeen non-forested category 1 wetlands, 2.587 acres of fifteen non-forested category 2 wetlands, 0.839 acres of three non-forested category 3 wetlands, 1.033 acres of two forested category 2 wetlands, 29,254 linear feet of eighty-three ephemeral streams, 34,162 linear feet of thirty-seven intermittent streams, 4,269 linear feet of six perennial streams, 1,163 linear feet (0.067 acres) of three jurisdictional ditches and 1.041 acres of two ponds. The applicant's proposed minimal degradation alternative, if approved, would impact: 2.064 acres of fifteen non-forested category 1 wetlands, 1.015 acres of eight non-forested category 2 wetlands, 0.839 acres of three non-forested category 3 wetlands, 22,471 linear feet of sixty-three ephemeral streams, 20,649 linear feet of twenty-three intermittent streams, 2,185 linear feet of five perennial streams, 1,163 linear feet (0.067 acres) of three jurisdictional ditches, and 1.041 acres of two ponds. The applicant's proposed non-degradation alternative, if approved, would have no direct impacts on waters of the state.

Discharges from the activity, if approved, would result in degradation to, or lowering of, the water quality of 37 wetlands, 126 streams, 3 jurisdictional ditches, and 2 ponds within the Lower Scioto (0506002) and Little Scioto-Tygarts (05090103) Watersheds. Ohio EPA will review the application, and decide whether to grant or deny the application, in accordance with OAC Chapters 3745-1 and 3745-32. In accordance with OAC rule 3745-1-05, an anti-degradation review of the application will be conducted before deciding whether to allow a lowering of water quality. All three proposed alternatives will be considered during the review process. No exclusions or waivers, as outlined by OAC rule 3745-1-05, apply or may be granted.

All interested persons are entitled to attend or be represented and give written or oral comments on the proposed project. The purpose of the hearing is to obtain additional information that will be considered by Ohio EPA prior to any further action on the application.
