NOTICE OF RECEIPT OF 401 APPLICATION**

Public notice is hereby given that the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) Division of Surface Water (DSW) has received an application for, and has begun to consider whether to issue or deny, a modification to a Clean Water Act Section 401 water quality certification for after the fact impacts for a project to construct 0.63 miles of 10 foot wide multi-use paved path. The application was submitted by the Ohio Department of Transportation. The project is located within East Fork State Park in Williamsburg Township, Clermont County. The Ohio EPA ID Number for this project is 124044.

The applicant's previously approved water quality certification, dated March 25, 2013 authorized impacts to 105 linear feet of one ephemeral stream and 150 linear feet of one perennial stream. The applicant's modification, if approved, would impact an additional 69 linear feet of one perennial stream and 0.003 acres of wetland.

Discharges from the activity, if approved, would result in degradation to, or lowering of, the water quality of one perennial tributary to William H. Harsha Lake and East Fork Little Miami River. Ohio EPA will review the application, and decide whether to grant or deny the modification, in accordance with OAC Chapters 3745-1 and 3745-32. In accordance with OAC rule 3745-1-05, an anti-degradation review of the application will be conducted before deciding whether to allow a lowering of water quality. No exclusions or waivers, as outlined by OAC rule 3745-1-05, apply or may be granted.
