The applicant's proposed preferred alternative, if approved, would impact 994 linear feet of five perennial streams, 1,242 linear feet of one intermittent stream, and 2,400 linear feet (0.61 acres) of one jurisdictional ditch. The applicant's proposed minimal degradation alternative, if approved, would impact 492 linear feet of four perennial streams, 1,269 linear feet of one intermittent stream, and 2,400 linear feet (0.61 acres) of one jurisdictional ditch. The applicant's proposed non-degradation alternative, if approved, would have no direct impacts on waters of the state.

Discharges from the activity, if approved, would result in degradation to, or lowering of, the water quality of Cosgray Ditch, George Geary Ditch (CD-Trib 1), Cramer Ditch, North Fork Indian Run, South Fork Indian Run and one unnamed tributary. Ohio EPA will review the application, and decide whether to grant or deny the application, in accordance with OAC Chapters 3745-1 and 3745-32. In accordance with OAC rule 3745-1-05, an anti-degradation review of the application will be conducted before deciding whether to allow a lowering of water quality. As required by the Anti-degradation Rule, 3745-1-05, of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC), three alternatives have been submitted for the project. The applicant's proposed preferred alternative, if approved, would impact 414 linear feet of ephemeral streams, and 308 linear feet of intermittent streams. The applicant's proposed minimal degradation alternative, if approved, would impact 284 linear feet of ephemeral streams, and 38 linear feet of intermittent streams. The applicant's proposed non-degradation alternative, if approved, would have no direct impacts on waters of the state.

Discharges from the activity, if approved, would result in degradation to, or lowering of, the water quality of Mill Creek. Ohio EPA will review the application, and decide whether to grant or deny the application, in accordance with OAC Chapters 3745-1 and 3745-32. In accordance with OAC rule 3745-1-05, an anti-degradation review of the application will be conducted before deciding whether to allow a lowering of water quality. All three proposed alternatives will be considered during the review process. No exclusions or waivers, as outlined by OAC rule 3745-1-05, apply or may be granted.
