The Southwest District Office is offering a free, one-day seminar to communities subject to the storm water permit program for small separate storm sewer systems (MS4 communities). The one-day seminar will provide information about the next five-year NPDES permit cycle for MS4 communities, as well as discuss Ohio EPA's expectations for the permit requirements.

The seminar will focus on the six "minimum control measures" provided by USEPA as the framework of storm water management plans. Experienced speakers will provide valuable insight into each control measure. In addition, Ohio EPA staff will be available to answer questions and accept feedback about the storm water permitting requirements.

Seating is limited to municipalities within Ohio EPA's Southwest District Office (including Brown, Butler, Champaign, Clark, Clermont, Clinton, Darke, Greene, Hamilton, Highland, Logan, Miami, Montgomery, Preble, Shelby and Warren Counties.)



- Merge onto S. Dixie Hwy
