By May 2008, your community is required to have a fully-operational Municipal Storm Water Management Program. This requires you to:

- provide education to your citizens, businesses and employees on storm water issues;
- provide opportunities for public involvement;
- have a program to proactively identify and eliminate illicit discharges to the storm sewer system;
- review plans for construction and post-construction runoff control;
- inspect new development sites for compliance with those plans; and
- implement pollution prevention practices at municipal operations.
